Summary

Public Health England released provisional data for the uptake of the seasonal influenza vaccine in GP registered patients and primary schools from 1 September to 31 January 2018 (28 February for healthcare workers).



The data is shown at Clinical Commissioning Group (CCG) level for GP registered patients, primary schools and at national and individual trust level for healthcare workers.
